Safety Concept: Behavior in Stormy Weather – Sipplingen, Lake Constance

Dear Participant, please read carefully the instructions <u>in case</u> of stormy weather during the workcamp. By participating in the workcamp you confirm to have read and to follow the instructions mentioned above.

1. Before the Storm

- Monitor weather warnings: Regularly check local weather forecasts and alerts from the German Weather Service (DWD) or Swiss Weather Service (Meteoschweiz).
- Follow the instructions of the camp leaders and the local host and <u>seek shelter</u> <u>immediately</u> in the solid building nearby in case of stormy weather. Leave your luggage and personal belongings in the big tent.

Close to the camping spot on the Yacht Harbor there is a solid sanitary building. Please go directly there and wait until the storm ends. Here you can see how to reach the solid building:



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2. During the Storm

- Avoid open spaces: Leave forests, open fields, and bodies of water immediately.

- Stay in the solid building until the storm is over. Close all windows and doors to

prevent damage from wind or rain.

- Listen to the instructions of the camp leaders and local host

3. After the Storm

- Avoid danger zones: Do not enter areas with fallen trees, downed power lines,

or flooding.
