

THE PROJECT IN SHORT



With the "Learning Lab(oratory) – quality non-formal education in the digital world" project, we aim to improve the quality of the non-formal and informal learning aspects of volunteering activities in our organisations, in both physical and online formats.

The project has 5 main components:

1. Learning Lab(oratory) Training Course (7-14 July 2022, Emen, Bulgaria)

Key aspects of the training: organising and running high-quality learning activities in both in-person and online environments, digital laboratory: gaining confidence in using various online tools, working on plans on how to offer inclusive volunteering opportunities and reach new groups who could then strengthen your organisation as volunteers. 2. Three thematic webinars (May-October 2022)

Three online webinars with guest experts on topics related to visual facilitation, impact measurement, and inclusion of persons with fewer opportunities.

3. Learning Lab(oratory) Pro Training Course (27 October - 3 November 2022, Poznań, Poland)

Key aspects of the training: reflecting on the learning experience, collecting good examples/practices, getting more in-depth on the topics of inclusion and blended and digital learning, new tools and trends in learning and development (e.g. Action Learning, gamification...), future steps (how to apply the knowledge and skills in practice), personal development of the trainers/educators (how to take care of ourselves and plan our learning path and growth), Open Space lab.

4. Practice time (July - December 2022)

Practising the learning moments in national teams, organising and running activities on a local level.

5. Facilitator's Cards, Infographic for Inclusion and an Open Webinar (December 2022)

The Facilitator's cards will be a checklist on how to organise a high-quality learning process.

Our Infographic on Inclusion will guide users on how to make non-formal learning activities more inclusive.

The Open Webinar will be an online event officially launching the tools and presenting their utility.

THE TRAINING COURSE - Learning Lab(oratory) Pro

We are ready to invite you to join a one-week training course "Learning Lab(oratory) Pro", which will take place between 27.10 and 3.11.2022 in Poznań, Poland.

At the training course, you will:

- understand better what quality non-formal learning is, what its elements are and how to provide such learning experiences to all young people,
- learn innovative methods for enhancing the learning processes directed toward young people,
- explore tools for supporting digital learning and online volunteering,
- find creative and engaging ways for turning regular educational activities into an online format,
- discuss how to provide more inclusive and versatile learning opportunities for young people, including such with fewer opportunities,
- exchange ideas, good practices, inspirations, and share resources,
- plan a follow-up action to take place in your local community upon the course completion.

All in all, we offer you an excellent learning opportunity that will support you to increase the quality of non-formal education activities you and your organisation are doing, and also a unique networking experience with fellow-minded people from across Europe.

FOR WHOM?

Our ideal course participants are educators and trainers (also to-be trainers), leaders, volunteers, and youth workers with an interest in non-formal education, online learning and its applications in their work with young people.

The most important for us is your motivation and willingness to provide high-quality non-formal education activities in online and in-person settings.



There are a few formal requirements you need to satisfy to join the training course:

- 1. You need to be a **resident of one of the 9 project countries** mentioned on the cover page.
- 2. You must be able to communicate in English (the working language of the course).
- 3. You must be at least 18 years of age.
- 4. You need to attend the whole course duration (there is no possibility to make exceptions).
- 5. You commit yourself to organise a **follow-up action** in your local community/country upon the course completion (it can be e.g. a workshop, webinar, training or other educational activity).

We explicitly encourage participants of all genders, abilities and ethnic backgrounds to apply!

WHEN?

The training course will last 7 days.

You need to arrive at the training venue on Thursday, 27th October 2022 before 2 p.m.

The course finishes on 2nd October, in the evening, therefore, **departures** are planned for **the night of 2**nd **November or the morning of Thursday, 3**rd **November 2022**.

WHERE?

The training course will take place in **Poznań**, a vibrant city with great transport connections (international trains and buses, airport, highway).

We are thrilled to invite you to a dream place that combines *city* and *nature*!

<u>Hotel Camping Malta</u> is a relaxing green area designed for groups and individuals who want to have a creative space for work and rest. Malta is a lake



(picture on the previous page), just 3 km from the Poznań Old Town, yet giving you a feeling that you are away from the city.

We will live at the lakeside in double bungalows with private bathrooms, adhering to all health & safety precautions. The outside temperature will be 5-10°C at that time but the houses will be fully heated and 100% comfortable!

Meals, including coffee breaks, will be served in the renowned Rycerska hotel restaurant at the hotel premises, just next to our training room.









These are just a few examples of attractions within the walking distance of our hotel (0.5-3 km):

- Poznań Old Town
- Malta Thermal Baths (an aquapark and pool complex)
- All-year-long Malta Ski slope (with skiing, downhill rafting and a toboggan run)
- Forests with rivers, ponds, and a treetop walking bridge
- Two rope parks
- Poznań New Zoo with an award-winning, vast and modern elephant enclosure













METHODS

Our working methods will base on the principles of adult learning, creating a stress-free and motivating environment where the human brain has a full capacity to learn.

You will often work in smaller groups to achieve the best results. All the methods will encourage active participation, creativity, initiative, and responsibility for one's learning process.

Gośka Tur, Poland:

I am a sociologist, trainer and educator, a certified member of the Polish Association of NGO Trainers and the owner of Pracownia Interakcji training company. Between 2015 and 2020, I was the International President of SCI.

I love helping participants to learn, reflect and grow, and I've been doing it for more than 20 years now, specialising in adult education, peace and conflict resolution, and leadership, often in the form of long-term educational processes. I work a lot online and here you can watch a recording of a series of webinars I ran last year on online facilitation.

Expect to learn much more at the training course!:)

There will be **2 more experts** involved:

- Marta Piwowarska from the Culture Without Barriers Foundation will lead a session on inclusion and accessibility;
- Martens Marta Langiewicz will lead 3 sessions on role-playing and storytelling in non-formal education.

CERTIFICATES

You will be awarded a training completion certificate, issued by SCI Poland, and additionally, you will receive a Youthpass certificate.

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

The food and accommodation as well as all organisational costs (additional insurance, training materials etc.), will be fully covered thanks to the co-financing by the European Union.

In addition, we can provide you with complimentary accommodation in Poznań in a youth hostel the night before the training course launch if it is essential due to the lack of transport alternatives.

Reimbursement of the travel tickets will be 100% up to the maximum amount after the receipt of the original documents. Maximum travel reimbursement will be according to the Erasmus+ rates:

- travel by plane: distance 100-499 km up to 180 euro, 500-1999 km up to 275 euro, 2000-2999 km up to 360 euro,
- green travel (bus, train, car sharing): distance 100-499 km up to 210 euro, 500-1999 km up to 320 euro.

If you are from Austria, Belgium, Germany, Serbia and Slovenia and you choose **green travel** (bus, train, car sharing), you can receive reimbursement of additional accommodation costs on the way to Poznań, as well as reimbursement of small expenses made while travelling.

Even though this is not a "getting to know Poland" project, you may also stay in Poland a few days before or after at your private expense, as long as the travel cost is not higher than the cost which you would bear if coming only for course duration - otherwise you will be asked to cover the difference.

We do not cover the costs of COVID tests, should you need one.



SUSTAINABILITY

Sustainable food: The food we provide will be vegetarian with vegan options. This is not just a practical decision, but also an ideological one: SCI believes in the values of sustainability and climate justice – and if we want to contribute to a more peaceful planet, we need to give up on animal agriculture and its destructive effects on our planet.

Sustainable travel: We encourage you to use environmentally friendly transport (bus, train, car sharing) when possible, and we will explicitly ask participants from Austria, Belgium, Germany, Serbia and Slovenia to choose this type of transport instead of a plane. Questions or doubts? Contact us!
