One World Association is happy to open application process for the project "Volunteering vs. Violence - Let's turn theory into practice" - creative camp aimed to built simulation game about non-violent communication and conflict resolution".


Content:

During 6-days creative camp we are going to create an educational simulation game that aims to help individual participants and organizations talk about violence, give examples of preventative grounds, and think about solutions to conflict or violence situations. Educational materials created during the project are to be a complement to the game, but they can also be the basis for starting discussion and working on the attitudes of individual participants and groups. Materials and the game are to be a way to relieve tensions and violence that affects us (including self-destructive violence directed to ourselves) using the proven method of "Non Violent Communication" and using new methods such as visual thinking / sketchnoting to deal with the situations. A very important point of the project is testing the game in individual partner countries and adapting it to their needs. The game will have the main axis, but the refinement will depend on the organizations participating in the project.

Participants from following countries can take part in the project: Albania, Bulgaria, Germany, Greece, Italy, Kosovo, Macedonia, Russia, Spain and Poland.

We consider hybrid version of the project as a plan B but stationery one is always our first choice and goal. We hope to host all the participants in Poznan with caution of all the current safety recommendations.

At the project you will:

- learn about the Non-Violent Communication and Visual Thinking methods
- learn how to construct simulation games
- create an educational game based on Non Violent Communications rules
- talk about violence and find out solutions which can help other people
- have the chance to experiment, exchange and cooperate with each other during and after the creative camp

- are willing to use the results of the training,
- want to test created game in your home country;
- are a resident of Germany
- are able to communicate well and work in English;
- are at least 18 years old (there is no maximum age);
- are available to attend the whole duration of creative camp.


When?

The creative camp is going to take place from 4.01.2021 to 11.07.2021 Participants' arrivals are foreseen on Sunday 4.07.2021 by 12 a.m. Departures will be on Sunday 11.07.2021

Where?

The event will be held in Poland. The creative camp venue is Poznan, city on the west of Poland.

Financial conditions

Food and accommodation for participants will be fully covered for the duration of the creative camp.
